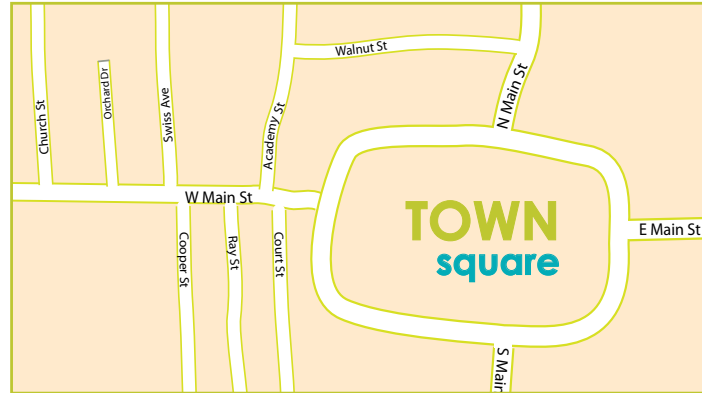

CLUE #1
This building just off the Square was established in 1833, and housed the likes of Elvis Presley, Mark Twain, Christopher Reeves and Thomas Wolfe. What is the name?

CLUE #11
Walk your "Blue Suede Shoes" towards the RAD Elvis wig. Peek inside the window of the restaurant. What do you see? Which one wears an orange headband?

CLUE #2
March east then north to a very tall, stone, grey pillar. On this are engraved names of people who have served in what way? Find a name that you recognize or find interesting.

CLUE #12
Cross the street at the crosswalk and head to a place where popcorn, candy and soda's are popular! What's playing?

CLUE #3
Head back to the center of the Square. Who is this person? Why do you think there is a sculpture of him here?

CLUE #6
Move faster than a turtle's pace to the next place! Head towards the square but don't cross the street! Search the outside of Town Hall for the year it was built.

CLUE #9
Hike on past the Lloyd Bailey Building. Conquer the flight of steps to the left. Behind the museum are three out buildings. How many horseshoes can you find?

CLUE #13
Are you getting thirsty yet? Relief is in sight! On the Northwest corner of the Square is a _____.
Drink up!

CLUE #4
Now head down South Main Street until you see a sculpture that is stainless steel and copper. What is the name of this piece of art?

CLUE #7
Now head west and cross Court St. and keep going until you see a grassy area. Don't Baaaaaack up! What do you see on the grass? What colors are they? How many do you see?



CLUE #14
If it's rivers you like to travel down, then drift northeast to a "Southern" place where you can rent these! Would you like to paddle down the river in these?

CLUE #5
In just a few steps hop across the street at the corner of the town center. What reptile is resting on a rock under the Do Not Block Intersection sign?

CLUE #8
Next "we're off to see the wizard!" Find the wizard of Oz mural. What colors are the flowers? Do you know what kind they are?

CLUE #10
Head on down to the old gas station that houses the Model T car. The Chamber of Commerce has a quilt pattern inside. What colors are in the pattern?

CLUE #15
Last, but not least, find out what time you completed your trek by locating the sundial on N. Main St. How does a sun dial work?
